- a) best dry single variety Malagousia
- b) best dry single variety Assyrtiko
- c) best dry single variety Moschofilero
- d) best dry red single variety Agiorgitiko
- e) best dry red single variety Xinomavro
- f) best dry single variety Xinisteri
- q) best dry or semi dry rose wine (residual sugars 0-12 q/L)
- h) best sparkling or semisparkling wine
- i) best **sweet wine** (residual sugars >40 g/L)

The organizers of the Competition publicise the prize-winners' list on local and foreign media, as well as on their websites: www.tiwc.gr and www.tiwc.gr and www.tiwc.gr and spirits is mailed to the participants and tasters, and distributed to the wine sector professionals and consumers.
